Next Sunday, 3 July, will be a significant day for many of us. At 11.00 am, Bishop Gregory will be preaching and presiding at Communion at St James'. Everyone is warmly invited to join us, in particular the 9.30 congregation from St John's, as the joint Church Council has decided that there will be no service at 9.30 that morning. Later that day, Bishop Gregory will be confirming candidates from across Wrexham, at a service at 3.00 pm at St Giles'. There are candidates from both our churches, so please keep them in your prayers as they prepare to make a public declaration of their faith, and receive Communion for the first time – you'll find details under the heading 'For Prayer' below

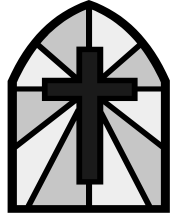
