# **Minister's Note**

Where will you be on Good Friday? Every year, I am struck by the fact that many of the people who are in church on Palm Sunday and Easter Day are nowhere to be seen during the days in between. It is as if many Christians want to forget, or try to ignore, the difficult, dark, painful, parts of the gospel story. It is uplifting and exhilarating to join with the crowds shouting 'Hosanna!' on Palm Sunday. It is a joy to join in the shouts of 'Alleluia, Christ is risen!' on Easter Day. But if our faith is to be true to the gospel, we also need to walk the Way of the Cross. We need to accompany Jesus to Calvary, to watch him nailed to the cross, to watch him die, and to watch as his body is laid in the tomb, before we can truly join in celebrating the Resurrection.

For St James' congregation, this is all particularly poignant, as we go through the difficult days running up to our own 'Good Friday', the closure of the Church. Maybe more of us will be moved to join in public worship during Holy Week this year, as it chimes with some of our own feelings. For St John's, I hope that you will support your brothers and sisters at St James' on Good Friday in particular, as we hold a joint service for both church families at St James' that morning.
